- 1. Welcome and Approval of Current Agenda & Minutes of the Spring Meeting in Vilnius, May 2019 Agenda was approved as were minutes of the working group's Spring meeting 2019.
- 2. Update on European Reference Networks
 Risto Lapatto reminded audience about European Reference Networks and explained their role. The
 participants were encouraged to find out about ERN members in their own countries.
- 3. The Impact of a Diagnosis: A Personal Account Saskia de Koster and her daughter Joosje Kist from the Netherlands gave a touching story on the life with their son/brother who got a molecular diagnosis of his disease more than 20 years after symptoms presented. The importance of diagnosis was clearly presented. The support and information from the facebook patient group has been very important.



4.Sustainable Development Goals, Universal Health
Coverage and Rare Diseases: What is the Least Paediatricians Can Contribute?
Liesbeth Siderius introduced the Universal Health Coverage (UHC) as adopted by the United Nations in September 2019. She then showed the results of the survey, done on the attitudes of EAP members on key UHC issues. 12th of December will be the UHC Day.
