Larnaca Castle

The Medieval Castle of Larnaka (also referred to as Larnaka Fort) is believed to have been originally built during the Middle Ages, and took its present form during Ottoman rule, although there is some contestation regarding its origins.



Finikoudes Beach

Larnaka's most famous promenade of Foinikoudes Beach is a 600-metre long stretch that combines coast, entertainment and culture along its palm-tree lined length. Make sure to return later in the day for some drinks at one of the bars on the promenade.
