Developing a strategy on the quality of PPC, 'change the domain'

- Maria Herzog PhD: Senior policy analyst, national project manager. Chief scientific advisor of Childonomics at Eurochild.
- Collaboration on finding proof of PPC superiority from economical/advocacy aspect
- EUROCHILD: a network of organizations and individuals working in and across

  Europe to promote the rights and well-being of children and young people
- Childonomics: framework measuring the long-term social and economic value of investing in children

# Developmental dysplasia of the hip (DDH)

- Early February: ICODE consensus paper circulated to EAP's one national delegates
   (one per country). No Response So Far.
- May: proposal to be endorsed online
- Request to interact with ICODE on addressing the Journal of American Academy
  of Orthopaedic Surgeons. JAAOS: paper published from Vancouver, CAN
  recommend that DDH detection could be cancelled/postponed to a later stage
  (over 4 months)
